A week ago I expressed support for decriminalising the possession of small amounts of marijuana and making the substance legal for medicinal and scientific purposes.

Our laws regarding the possession of small amounts of marijuana have unfortunately led to the arrest, prosecution, conviction and punishment of many

Some of these people have been burdened with criminal records, making travel and finding work more difficult.

Reforming our marijuana laws and changing how we treat people with small possession convictions is a matter of social justice.

I support expunging the records of Bahamians convicted of possession of small amounts of marijuana. They deserve to move on with their lives free and clear of a

I eagerly await the release of the report by the Bahamas National Commission on Marijuana. My Government will use the report's findings to help reform our

Part of this reform should be expunging the records of Bahamians convicted of possession of small amounts of marijuana. Being from the Over-the-Hill community, I have seen firsthand how our current laws especially harm young people from modest backgrounds.

The Commission's findings will be widely circulated and we welcome the input of Bahamians as we make these long-needed changes to various laws.

A Rehabilitation of Offenders Committee has been formed and is reviewing a number of matters for recommendation, including the possible expunging of some criminal records for possession of small amounts of marijuana. We will also take into consideration the recommendations of this committee.




mother got pranked over the internet last week from her clever kids and husband when she came home after a long day of work. She is our bongie of the day because she fell right for this one perfectly.

12% VAT CAN TURN INTO 15% CASUALLY COME 2020

But we get it, it the nearest 5, making costs more to produce a penny and therefore it only made sense to eliminate it from our currency. Now don't get us wrong we have seen thousands of Pennies thrown on the ground outside of so many stores locallý.

come January, the creation of the penny will however the penny will still be accepted until December 2020. Readers should take note of this and get rid of all your pennies now.

What could be a chilling truth is that the VAT

would also be affected with an increase with this new penny rule. It's being told that if your VAT is over the middle mark which is 3 cents it rounds off to it now 15 cents you will have to pay, so in not so many words hello 15% VAT but if it is under the 3 cents mark its supposed to round off to 10 cents total VAT but we need more clarity from the government on this penny rule and VAT.






COMMONWEALTH BANK OPENS IN ABACO!




